## **Complete a Practice Room (PR) Application**

• PR applications forms are located online at <a href="https://www.midland.edu/academics/degrees/arts/music.php">https://www.midland.edu/academics/degrees/arts/music.php</a> under the "Resources" area. Your instructor will help you complete this application during your first meeting with them. Applications must be returned to the Fine Arts Division Office, Room 135 of the Allison Fine Arts (AFA) building. All Practice Room Applications must be submitted by the end of the first week of the semester.

#### Sign-up for a Practice Room

• Practice Room sign-up begins the <u>second week</u> of the semester. You may only sign-up after you have completed a Practiced Room Application. Sign-up is done on the posted room schedules located on each practice room door. Sign-up is done on a first-come, first-serve basis. Please note that when you schedule a time slot it repeats weekly until the end of the semester.

### **Complete the Online MC Scholarship Application**

• All music students must complete MC's Online Scholarship Application. The application is located at www.midland.edu/scholarships. These scholarships are usually awarded on a first-come, first-serve basis by MC's Financial Aid Office. Each application you submit is good for one calendar year; the application resets in January during the first week of the Spring semester.

## **Complete a Music Scholarship Application**

 All applied, ensemble and piano class students must complete a printed Music Scholarship Application. Music scholarship applications are available from the wall rack near AFA 121. All Music Scholarship applications should be submitted by the end of the <u>second</u> <u>week</u> of the semester.
