ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

New Applicants

1. Application must be submitted to the Midland College Financial Aid Office no later than April 1, 2005.
2. Applicant must be an Abell-Hanger Society Inductee.
3. Applicant must be a graduate or be graduating from Midland College.
4. Applicant must have a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.50 or better on course work completed at Midland College.
5. Applicant must state the intention to enroll as a full-time student (12 or more hours) at Sul Ross State University in the Fall term.
6. Applicant must be accepted for regular admission as a degree seeking student at Sul Ross and must attach a copy of the letter of acceptance to this application.

Continued Eligibility

1. Applicant must have successfully completed at least 12 semester credit hours in the previous semester.
2. Applicant must maintain a Cumulative GPA of 2.25 or better on course work completed at Sul Ross State University.
3. Copy of grade report and brief note on progress must be furnished to the Foundation before funding will be made.

AWARDING AND DISBURSEMENT

1. Selection will be made by Abell-Hanger Foundation based on the recommendation of the President of Midland College. Recommendations will be based on academic achievement, community contribution, and financial need.
2. Selected recipients will be announced at the Abell-Hanger Society Induction Ceremony each Spring.
3. The amount of the scholarship will not exceed \$1,000.00 per semester but may vary from semester to semester and from year to year based on the number of recommended applicants and available funding.
4. All awards will be disbursed according to the policies and procedures of Sul Ross State University upon enrollment as a full-time student at the University.
5. Any deficiency may be made up during the summer terms, prior to registration for the following Fall semester.
6. Awards will be paid for Fall and Spring semesters only.
