ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

New Applicants

1. Application must be submitted to the Midland College Financial Aid Office no later than **April 1, 2005**.
2. Applicant must be an Abell-Hanger Society Inductee.
3. Applicant must be a graduate or be graduating from Midland College.
4. Applicant must have a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or better on course work completed at Midland College.
5. Applicant must state the intention to enroll as a full-time student (12 or more hours) at UT Permian Basin in the Fall term.
6. Applicant must be accepted for regular admission as a degree seeking student at UT Permian Basin and must attach a copy of the letter of acceptance to this application.

Continued Eligibility

1. Applicant must have successfully completed at least 12 semester credit hours in the previous semester.
 2. Applicant must maintain a Cumulative GPA of 2.75 or better on course work completed at UT Permian Basin.

AWARDING AND DISBURSEMENT

1. Selection will be made by The University of Texas Permian Basin from the list of eligible applicants recommended by the President of Midland College. Recommendations will be based on academic achievement, community contribution, and financial need.
2. The amount of the scholarship will not exceed \$500.00 per semester but may vary from semester to semester and from year to year based on the number of recommended applicants and available funding.
3. All awards will be disbursed according to the policies and procedures of the University of Texas Permian Basin upon enrollment as a full-time student at the University.
