Deadline: April 1, 2005

Listed below are the requirements set forth by The A.T. Carrasco Educational Foundation:

GUIDELINES

- Amount of Scholarship: Maximum amount is \$500.00 a semester. It is renewable for two (2) years or (4) semesters if qualifications are met.
- Recipient to be selected: Applicant must graduate with an Associate Degree from Midland College and must participate in the graduation ceremony. Recipient will be selected by the A.T. Carrasco Educational Foundation.
- Method of payment: Payment is made directly to the college each semester based upon expenses.
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SPECIFIC QUALIFICATIONS

1. No restrictions as to race, creed or sex of recipient.
 2. Scholastic Achievement: Major Factor-minimum 2.5 GPA.
 3. Extracurricular Activities: Major Factor-Participation in school activities with good citizenship record.
 4. Financial Need: With all other factors equal, this becomes the major factor.
 5. Student must be a resident of Texas and attend an accredited college or university in the U.S.A.
 6. A specific course of study is not necessary, but student must be in an approved degree program.
 7. Student must be and remain unmarried.
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GENERAL ELIGIBILITY

Foundation may discontinue scholarship for the following reasons:

1. Disciplinary action by college or university.
2. Student marrying while receiving the scholarship.
3. Failure to maintain a 2.5 GPA with a minimum of twelve (12) hours each semester.

Application must be accompanied by transcript and two (2) letters of reference.

Applications must be turned in to the financial aid office on April 1, 2005
