SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS**

1. **Must have taken and passed the GED at MC within the last 12 months.**
2. Scholastic achievement: This is a competitive scholarship based on GED scores.
3. Student must enroll in at least 6 credit hours to receive the scholarship.
4. Application should be accompanied by a copy of your **GED certificate**, including scores, to be eligible.
5. **Student must turn in a thank you card to the Scholarship Office. If thank you card is not turned in by required date, scholarship will be revoked for following semester.**

SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

1. **FUND LIMIT**- The Abell-Hanger Foundation provides funding for the Midland College Scholarship program. Scholarships are awarded on a first-come, first-serve basis until the funds are depleted. It is the student's responsibility to submit an application in time to be awarded.
2. **TIME LIMIT**- Students who maintain satisfactory academic progress are eligible for 4 consecutive semesters of funding from date scholarship was received.
3. **COVERAGE LIMITS**- The Abell-Hanger GED Scholarship only covers tuition and fees up to \$650 per semester for full-time enrollment. The scholarship is only applicable for Fall and Spring semesters, no Summer or Interim sessions are covered. The scholarship does not include books. Funds may not be exceeded or carried over.
4. **MAINTAIN ELIGIBILITY**- Students enrolled in 12 or more hours (on the census date), must complete at least 9 hours with a GPA of 2.0. All part-time students (less than 12 semester hours) must complete at least 75% of the hours attempted with a 2.0 and must at no time drop below 6 semester hours. If a student does not meet the minimum hour or GPA requirements, the scholarship will be forfeited. Students may appeal only if the failure to meet these requirements was the result of medical, military or undue hardship conditions. The student may be reinstated if he/she enrolls in at least 6 credit hours using other funds to pay for their tuition and fees and upon completion of these hours maintains a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or above. If this is achieved, the student can possibly be reinstated in the next year. However, reinstated awards will be made after all other qualified applicants are awarded and dependent upon available funds.
