
The College of Arts and Sciences and the Chemistry Program at Texas A&M University-Kingsville and Midland College enter into a 2+2 agreement involving programs in Chemistry leading to the Bachelor of Chemistry degree. This agreement focuses the following goal:

An articulation agreement resulting in a seamless transfer to the Chemistry Program in the College of Arts and Sciences by students from Midland College. The agreement is focused around students completing their first two years at Midland College and receiving an Associate's degree before transferring to TAMUK's College of Arts and Sciences in good standing. A 2+2 Agreement will outline the courses accepted at Texas A&M University-Kingsville for transfer students in Chemistry from Midland College.

The details of the agreement are outlined in the attached Transfer Plans. When degree plans change it is up to the signatories to make sure the other institution knows of changes were made. The agreement will be reviewed every year by Transfer Team in Admission Office; however will not need new signatures until five years after sign date.
