ESL (English as a Second Language), refers to the study of English by non-native speakers. Midland College offers free English as a Second Language (ESL) classes designed to help students with Reading, Writing, and Speaking the English Language. These skills are taught in conjunction with survival life skills to help the student compete and function fully in the community.

ESL/Citizenship, after completing the program the student will have the necessary tools essential for achieving U.S citizenship.

ESL/Spanish GED (General Education Development), is based on a group of five subject tests which, when passed, certify that the taker has American high school-level academic skills. Students will receive the tools necessary to complete the GED.
