Guide for What to Bring

Below is a list of items students have brought to make their room a home. Please note the “PROHIBITED” portion of the list, items may be confiscated and residents may face college disciplinary action if they bring those items into the residence hall rooms.

FOR YOUR ROOM:

Alarm Clock

Bed Linens, Covers and Pillows

(O’Shaughnessy/Craddick Hall – regular twin sheets; Men’s – extra long twin sheets)

Cleaning Products and Supplies

Clothing

(Both warm and cool weather clothing are recommended; average temperatures in fall and spring are in the 80’s and in winter 60’s, but daily high temperatures can drop into the 20’s in winter or rise into the 90’s fall and spring)

Computer

(Please make sure you have an active and updated antivirus program running and a current operating system. Also double check for and remove programs that are illegal, involve web sharing, or are against Midland College Computer Policy - see enclosed flyer)

First Aid, Sewing, and Small Tool Kit

Iron with automatic shut off and Ironing Board
