All tests require a valid photo ID such as a driver's license, DPS identification card, school ID, or passport at the time the test is administered.

ACT Administered on national testing dates established by ACT. For Registration, test dates, payment or other inquiries contact ACT at www.act.org or your high school counselor.

CLEP Pre-registration at the Testing Center is required. Set up an account at www.collegeboard.org Each CLEP exam is \$80 paid through your College Board account. The proctoring fee for each CLEP is \$25 paid at the Midland College Cashier's Office. Bring the \$25 receipt to the Testing Center to reserve a spot.

CREDIT BY DEPARTMENTAL EXAM See the appropriate academic division for information.

EXAMS FOR OTHER COLLEGES Proctoring of distance learning course examinations and/of online exams is available to students taking courses from other college and universities. An appointment must be scheduled. A \$25 Proctor Fee is paid at the Cashier's Office for each proctored exam from another institution. MAKE-UP EXAMS The Testing Center provides assistance to Midland College faculty by proctoring make-up exams. These tests are arranged by the student on an as-needed basis with the individual faculty member. Students need to schedule a time by calling (432) 685-4504 or testing@midland.edu

MATH PLACEMENT EXAMS A Math Placement Exam is offered on a walk-in basis in the Testing Center. This exam is administered at no cost to the student. The Math Placement Exam is for those students wanting to register for a math course above MATH 1314, MATH 1324, and MATH 1342.

ONLINE MIDLAND COLLEGE EXAMS There is no fee for students taking online courses through Midland College. Students are required to schedule an appointment in advance by calling (432) 685-4504 or emailing testing@midland.edu

SAT Administered on national testing dates established by the College Board. For Registration, test dates, payment or other inquiries contact the College Board at www.collegeboard.org or your high school counselor.

TEAS Administered every Thursday morning at 8:30 AM. Students must register in advance at the Testing Center to schedule a test day and to receive instructions for creating an account at www.atitesting.com The exam fee is \$45 payable ONLY by debit or credit card on the morning of the exam. Proctoring fees are \$10 for students applying for Midland College Allied Health programs and \$25 for students planning to attend other colleges.

TSI ASSESSMENT Administered on a walk-in basis. The \$29 testing fee is paid to the Cashier's Office prior to testing. Bring the receipt to the Testing Center when arriving to begin the exam. The Pre-Assessment Activity (PAA) must be completed BEFORE testing. Go to www.midland.edu/pre-assessment to complete the PAA.
