

**Midland College
FERPA WAIVER
Education Information**

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 establishes the privacy rights of students (parents if the student is under 18) with regard to educational records which are not classified as directory information. The act makes provision of inspection, review, and amendment of educational records by the student and requires, in most instances, prior consent from the student for disclosure of such records to third parties. The consent must be in writing, signed and dated by the student and must specify records to be released. The act applies to all persons formerly and currently enrolled at an educational institution. No exclusion is made for non- U.S. citizen students. However, the act does not apply to a person who has applied for admissions, but who never actually enrolled in or attended the institution, and deceased persons.
