FLC PARTICIPANT OUTCOMES

- Discover and share **best practices and resources** related to teaching and learning.
- **Connect and collaborate** with Midland College faculty colleagues on a variety of teaching and learning topics.
- Design and prepare course materials that apply concepts discussed in the FLC.
- Engage in research and discussion on the scholarship of teaching and learning.

FLC STRUCTURE AND FORMAT

- Participation in this FLC counts for up to 8 hours of professional development.
- The FLC will include **collaborative discussion sessions** with faculty colleagues.
- Sessions will consist of peer-led discussions based on specific areas of teaching and learning that are
 of interest to the faculty participants.
- The FLC will include **resource and discussion areas within Microsoft Teams** for asynchronous engagement and discussion between sessions.

EXPECTATIONS OF FLC PARTICIPANTS

It is expected that FLC participants:

- Attend and fully engage in all FLC sessions.
- Lead (or co-lead) at least one discussion on a teaching and learning topic. Faculty will prepare talking points and discussion prompts based on a book, article, idea, or personal experience as an educator.
- Share resources, best practices, and experiences that relate to the session topic.
- Engage in asynchronous content sharing and discussion.
- Ask questions that prompt faculty participants and encourage interaction and engagement.
- Apply practices and suggestions discussed in the session and report back the results to the group.
