

PURPOSE AND OVERVIEW

The New Employee Experience (NEE) will orient and equip new employees with the tools, resources, and knowledge necessary to be successful employees at Midland College.

This program is designed to help new employees create important relationships with their colleagues across the college and create a purposeful sense of belonging for new employees.

The NEE is a program for all new employees at Midland College. New employees are expected to participate in this program.

BENEFITS OF PARTICIPATING:

- 1. Employees will learn general institutional knowledge including:
 - general organizational, reporting structure, and strategic direction of Midland College;
 - academic, workforce, and continuing education programs at Midland College;
 - basic information technology and online platforms supported by Midland College;
 - institutional efforts to promote diversity, equity, and inclusion across Midland College;
 - key components of Title IX and FERPA and how they impact the employees' role.
- 2. Employees will learn the available student programs and support including:
 - dual credit and early college high school (ECHS) programs at Midland College;
 - the various student support services and activities available to students;
 - the various instructional support services and mechanisms available to students;
 - STRIVE, Midland College's Quality Enhancement Plan.
- 3. There are sessions specific to faculty in the NEE that only faculty are expected to attend. Faculty will learn expectations and procedures relating to **teaching and learning** including:
 - the faculty evaluation process;
 - ways for faculty to get involved in various projects, work groups, and committees at Midland College;
 - the MC Portal, Canvas, Zoom, and other Midland College instructional platforms,
 - the structure and purpose of faculty-specific committees;
 - expectations for engaging students in their courses.
