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#### **WELCOME TO KIDS' COLLEGE 2024 AT MIDLAND COLLEGE!**

KIDS' COLLEGE is a summer enrichment program for students who will be completing kindergarten through sixth grade this spring. The curriculum has been developed to offer courses that are fun and educational, in a college-like setting. We invite you to look over our schedule and make Kids' College a part of your summer plan!

To be eligible for Kids' College, students must have completed Kindergarten through 6th grades in the 2023-2024 school year.

### **FEES**



Classes will range from \$50 to \$120 per class.

Two classes will be offered each week and most classes will meet for one class timeslot and then the child will switch classes and go to their second class timeslot. We will have a few classes (Computer classes, Summer STEM Discovery, Makers' Space, etc.) which meet during both class timeslots.

Students MUST be signed up for the full time from 1:00 p.m. to 4:45 p.m. (either two classes or one of the longer classes that meet during both timeslots).



#### **REGISTRATION PROCESS**

Online registration will open to the public on Monday, March 25, 2024.

- 1. Complete the online registration form (available on the website, www.midland.edu/kidscollege)
  - a. Submit a separate registration form for each student attending.
  - b. Register student in a class for BOTH class timeslots (either two separate classes or one of the longer classes that meets during both timeslots).
  - c. Student MUST be registered for the full afternoon, from 1:00 p.m. to 4:45 p.m.; there are no late drop-offs or early pick-ups.
  - d. You may also contact us via email (cecommunityprograms@midland.edu) to receive the link to register.
- 2. Once the registration form is submitted, the registration will be reviewed and finalized. If there are questions, we will contact the person listed on the application.
- 3. When the registration is finalized, a confirmation email with an invoice for payment will be sent. Payment is due when the invoice is received. Lack of payment will result in child being dropped from Kids' College.
- 4. To pay the invoice:

    - i. Regular hours: Monday Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
    - ii. Summer hours: Monday Thursday, 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.

- 5. If payments are made by May 12th, a 10% Early Bird Discount Applies. Payments after May 12th will be the full price.
- 6. FINAL Registration and payment date is May 28th. No more registrations will be accepted after May 28th and any students with unpaid balances will be dropped.
- 7. Student Schedules and Name Tags will be available for pick up from the Kids' College Temporary Office at Midland College beginning Monday, May 20.
  - a. Office location is F. Marie Hall Academic Building Rm. 130. Click here for a campus map.
  - b. If you are unable to pick up your student's name tag and schedule, we will have a check-in table at the student drop-off on the first day of each session.

Fees will be refunded ONLY if a student withdraws by noon on the Tuesday before the first day of the session - NO EXCEPTIONS. A \$10 processing fee will be deducted from the refund. ### **KIDS' COLLEGE POLICIES**



#### **ATTENDANCE**

Students are expected to attend each class for which they are enrolled. They are to remain in their class except during breaks. A child should not attend a class that they are not enrolled in. Please communicate with your child which classes they are enrolled in.

#### **NAME TAGS**

Students are expected to wear their name tags for the duration of their time at Kids' College. If your child loses their name tag, please contact the Kids' College office via email for a replacement (cecommunityprograms@midland.edu).

#### CONDUCT

Since the purpose of Kids' College is to provide an enrichment program, proper standards of conduct are necessary to protect the health, safety and well-being of all Kids' College students:

- Behavior that might interfere with the educational process is unacceptable.
- Students will be respectful of other students and staff.
- Students will be careful with college equipment, property and the property of other students.
- Safety of students is our first responsibility. Students MAY NOT GO ANYWHERE on campus without being accompanied by a staff member.

- Parents will be contacted if their child is involved in any unacceptable situations during the day. If you have been contacted due to unacceptable behavior, you will be asked to pick up your child.
- Staff members have the right, at any time, to exclude any child from activities due to failure or inability to follow, as directed, any rules and/or policies for participants.

#### STUDENTS RISK EXPULSION FROM THE PROGRAM IF:

- The student steals or is caught stealing another person's property,
- Threats of bodily injury,
- Physical contact of any kind.

#### **BREAKS/FOOD/WATER**

There will be a break between the first and second class timeslots to allow for classroom changes and a refreshment break.

Students should bring a refillable water bottle with them each day. Water to refill water bottles will be available during Kids' College. Bottled water will not be provided.

#### **DROP-OFF/PICK-UP**

Drop-off/Pick-up will be in the parking lot of the F. Marie Hall Academic Building (map on last page - page 31). The process for drop-off and pick-up is as follows:

- Drop-off will begin at 12:45 p.m., not earlier. Staff will not be available before this time
- Students who already have their name tag and schedule may be dropped off and will be directed to line up with their first class.
- Students who HAVE NOT received their name tag and schedule MUST come to the check-in table when arriving.
- Pick-up will begin at 4:45 p.m. The students will be brought to their vehicle, so please remain in the car in the pick-up line. Please display the name sign we provide to expedite the pick-up process.

Carpool ends at 5:15 p.m. Any student left after 5:15 p.m. will be taken to F. Marie Hall Academic Building Rm. 130, (432) 685-4518.

If you must park and pick up your child, please assist Kids' College staff and wait for the flow of traffic to stop before stepping into the line of traffic. Security is essential to the safety of your children during Kids' College, which is why campus police officers will assist Kids' College staff with traffic. Your patience and cooperation is appreciated. Traffic assistants are strictly guided by the Midland College Police Department - please follow all instructions and do not deviate.
