## **7 THINGS YOU WILL NEED TO COMPLETE THE FAFSA**

- Your FSA ID (username and password): We can help you get a username and password.  
⇒ Each student, and one parent of each dependent student, will need a FSA ID
- Your Social Security number
- Your driver's license number
- 2020 tax records: ⇒ Your 2020 W2s ⇒ Your parents 2020 tax records and W2s if you are a dependent student
- Records of any untaxed income, may or may not apply to you, such as:  
⇒ Child support received      ⇒ Interest income      ⇒ Veterans non-education benefits
- Records of your assets, such as:  
⇒ Savings and checking account balances      ⇒ Stocks and bonds      ⇒ Real estate (not the home in which your family lives)
- If applicable, Alien Registration Number
