- be enrolled Fall 2024 semester for 6 to 12 credit hours.
- have a 2.5 or higher cumulative GPA
- have completed 10 hours of volunteer work prior to applying
- demonstrate a financial need

APPLICATION PREFERENCES:

- possess a high school diploma or GED
- If applicant is currently attending Midland College, student must:
 - o meet Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) standards.
 - o not be on federal financial aid suspension from Midland College.

ESSAY

A typed essay dated and signed, between 200 - 300 words, double-spaced, expressing your educational and career goals must be submitted. Explain how you have demonstrated leadership in the Hispanic community, or in any other aspects either in school, extracurricular activities, and family and / or community activities.
