

- Clean empty far with a secure lid. A peanut butter jar works great
- Washable paint we used red and two shades of pink.
- Cardstock white and pink
- Candy Hearts (dried beans or small marbles work well too)
- Gluestick

You'll need.

Start by cutting your white eard stock to fit your jar. I cut mine in halt (8.5°x5.5°) and it fit perfectly.

Add if (ow drops of paint to the bottom of your jat, fust a couple of drops will do! Carefully slide the paper inside and wrap it around the sides. Add 5 6 caudy hearts (or dried beans). Close the lid securely. Invite your kids to shake it up! Let them make noise, shake, and shimmy as much as they want. When they are done, carefully remove the paper and allow it to dry.

Once it is completely dry, out out heart shapes in any size you'd. like.
