Notice to Scholars' Dollars Recipients

Scholars' Dollars is a scholarship fund in which businesses throughout Fort Stockton donate to assist students attending the Williams Regional Technical Training Center in Fort Stockton, Texas. This critical fund has assisted hundreds of students over the years and welcomes the opportunity to support Midland College students attending the Williams Regional Technical Training Center campus. For students who do not receive federal financial aid, this scholarship offers much needed assistance. Scholars' Dollars also reaches out to students in continuing education areas, such as, English as a Second language, Certified Nursing Assistant program, and technical certificates.

Scholars' Dollars funds are allocated after federal financial aid and outside scholarships are awarded. Scholars' Dollars funds are awarded to cover any remaining balances for tuition/fees and textbooks. In the event, a student who is receiving federal financial aid funds is "over awarded", the Scholars' Dollars awarded will be returned to the Scholars' Dollars fund.

The Scholars' Dollars Board is open to "special circumstances". The student may submit a written document as an attachment to their application. This document should identify and explain their specific circumstances and needs.

Guidelines and Criteria

Before you apply:

- 1. Apply for admission to Midland College through <u>www.goapplytexas.org</u>.
- 2. Apply for federal financial aid by completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at <u>www.studentaid.gov</u>.
- 3. Attach a copy of your Midland College transcript if you have credit hours earned with Midland College or an outside college or university. An unofficial copy, which is acceptable for this scholarship, is available on the "My MC1 Portal".
- 4. After completing the application, keep this page and a copy of your application for your personal records.
- 5. Submit the completed application with your transcript (if applicable) and confirmation of your SAI (Student Aid Index) to Josie Hernandez-Scholars' Dollars Coordinator. *The SAI was formerly the EFC number associated with the financial information the student provided on the FAFSA.

Eligibility:

- 1. Pecos County residents who are attending WRTTC campus in Fort Stockton, Texas.
- 2. Scholars' Dollars awards may not be transferred to any other school or campus.
- 3. Eligible students may be awarded Scholars' Dollars for up to 60 credit hours. However, consideration based on a case by case need will be considered.
- 4. To remain eligible for a Scholars' Dollars award, a student must maintain a 2.0 GPA each semester.

It is important that students plan for the expenses associated with enrolling in college courses. Tuition and fees are the responsibility of the student.

Deadline:

- 1. Applications should be submitted no later than the **FIRST** week in **August** for the **FALL** semester.
- 2. Application should be submitted no later than the **FIRST** week in **December** for the **SPRING** semester.
- 3. No LATE applications will be accepted, strict adherence to the scholarship deadline is required.

Selection Process:

- 1. Scholarship selection is made by the Scholars' Dollars Board.
- 2. Applications will be presented to the Board and will be identified by the last four digits of the student's Midland College ID number. (This number is assigned to the student when they apply for admission to Midland College). Student name and identifying information is removed from the application.
- 3. The SD Board will consider all the information on the application and gives much weight to the essay questions. Therefore, it is important that your information be concise and accurate. Students are encouraged to take their time to plan and document their answers to explain their situation fully.
- 4. After the SD Board's consideration of the application, the amount of scholarship, if any, will be determined for each applicant.
- 5. A scholarship award letter will be provided to the student by the Scholars' Dollars Coordinator.
